The rapid growth of the share of energy generated via renewable sources highly challenges grid stability. Flexibility is key to balance the electricity supply and demand. For example, uncertainties in weather forecasts can lead to unexpected peaks in the electricity supplied by RESs. The supply by RESs can only be controlled to a limited extent as, while RESs can be curtailed, upwards adjustments of supply are limited to the respective source of electricity generation, such as solar energy or wind. An increased or decreased feed-in compared to the forecasted one can destabilize the electricity grid and, hence, it requires cost-intensive grid balancing activities such as redispatch measures. For example, German Transmission System Operators (TSOs) spent 207.1 million Euros on redispatch measures in 2019 (Bundesnetzagentur, 2019).
